

Things you need to apply for the TN Promise

1. Your Social Security number
2. An email account

(If you do not have an email account, go to <https://accounts.google.com/SignUp> and set one up. Write down your user name and password!)

Note: You must be a US citizen to apply.

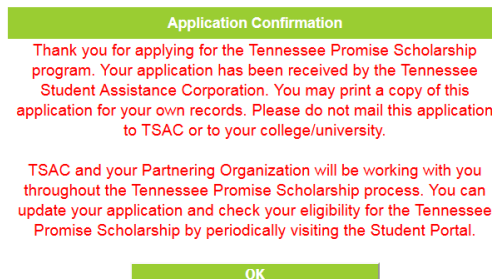
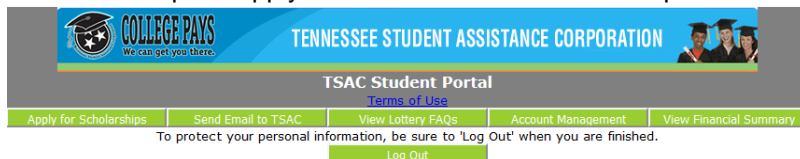
Go to www.TNPromise.gov

- Click on the blue High School Seniors Apply Now.
- In the “TSAC Student Portal,” scroll down and select “Click to Register” or “Sign In” if you already have an account. (If you have applied for the dual enrollment grant, you already have an account!)
- Create your account.
- Apply for the scholarship.



Tips to follow

- **Write down or take a picture of user name, password, and answers to the challenge questions. You will need them in the future.**
- Use your legal first and last names. Fill in info using initial caps. (First Name Madison not MADISON; Address 201 Elm Dr not 201 E1M DR)
- **User name** must be 6–25 characters and must include letter(s) and number(s.) You may not use special characters (‘ # *) or blank spaces.
- **Password** must be 6–25 characters and must include letter(s) and number(s.) You may not use special characters (‘ # *) or blanks. Passwords are case sensitive and may not contain your user name, first name, or last name.
- Numbers (birth date, SSN#, phone) are formatted for you in account creation. You must enter using the proper format when you apply for the scholarship.
- Select a **personal image**.
- Check the “**I acknowledge**” Terms and Conditions.
- Click on “**Create My Account.**”
- Sign into your account and click on the “**Apply for Scholarships**” tab. Follow the steps to apply for the TN Promise Scholarship.
